

Pre-requisite: Please inform our support team to enable the feature.

1. Setup Daily Gold Price


- a. From menu, go to Stock > Manage > Gold Price.
- b. Fill up daily gold price for different fineness.
- c. This gold price is needed when issue sales invoice.





2. Setup Jewelry Items

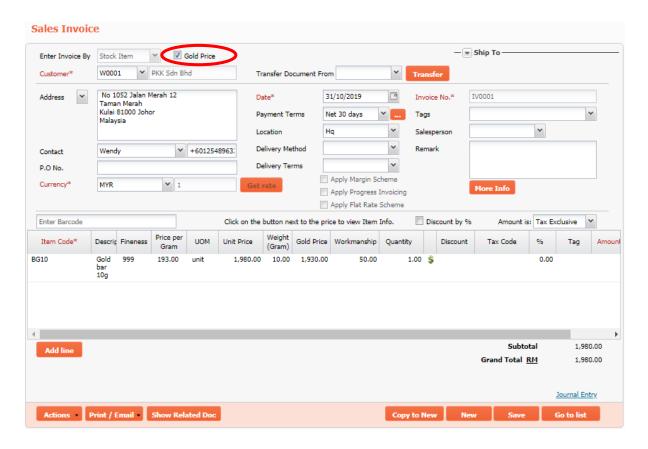
- a. From menu, go to Stock > Manage > Stock Items.
- b. Fill up jewelry item with respective Fineness, Weight, and Workmanship.
- c. The Fineness, Weight, and Workmanship is needed when issue sales invoice.





3. Issue Sales Invoice for Jewelry Items


- a. From menu, go to Sales > Sales Invoice.
- b. Fill up necessary information and make sure "Gold Price" is checked.
- c. Amount will be auto calculated based on selected jewelry, respective daily gold price, fineness, weight, workmanship, and quantity.





4. Check the Stock Balance


- a. From menu, go to Stock > Reports > Stock Balance.
- b. Fill up necessary information and generate report.
- c. The report will show balance in both quantity and weight.





5. Check the Sales Report

- a. From menu, go to Sales > Reports > Sales Report by Item.
- b. Fill up necessary information and generate report.
- c. The report will show the sales transactions for each jewelry.
